♦Invoices for actual costs **must be received by the Solano County Fair Association by May 10, 2018.** The Solano County Fair Association will pay the invoice directly, not to exceed the approved funding amount.

**Invoices received by the Solano County Fair Association that are not approved in advance, and/or are received after May 10, 2018 are the responsibility of the school.**
