## **Fair Board announces 2021 Solano County Fair theme: “Solano Fair on the Air.”**

Vallejo, CA – The Solano County Fair Association (SCFA) announced that the theme for the 2021 Solano County Fair will be “**Solano Fair on the Air**”.

The annual Solano County Fair will again be held virtually in 2021. The 2021 Solano County Fair dates are June 17<sup>th</sup> through June 20<sup>th</sup>. The 2021 “Solano Fair on the Air” theme builds upon the award winning 2020 virtual Solano County Fair.

Prior to deciding on a virtual Fair format, the SCFA Board of Directors at their Wednesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> meeting, met to discuss the possibility of creating a hybrid 2021 Fair. The proposed hybrid model: virtual fair offerings combined with some traditional Fair activities plus the already approved and scheduled onsite livestock activities was discussed and analyzed, but eventually found unworkable.

“This was a very tough decision”, stated SCFA Board President, Manuel Angel. “Our Board had a very spirited discussion, as everyone at SCFA, including the Board, staff and volunteers, truly want to return to the traditional fair format and celebrate Solano County the way we do best. This year, more than ever, we all felt our community’s need to celebrate and return to some sense of normalcy.

In the end we all agreed that SCFA’s commitment to continue to host the mass vaccination clinic, which currently utilizes the majority of the fairgrounds, combined with the uncertainty as to how large public gatherings will be regulated in the near future, pointed the Board back to a virtual format.”

The Solano County Fairgrounds has hosted a mass vaccination clinic since early February. To date, over 86,000 doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered at the fairgrounds.

Angel did point out that plans are in the works to recognize vaccination clinic personnel during the 2021 Solano County Fair dates. “We are working on some ideas that would honor and applaud our partners in the vaccination clinic efforts,” Angel said. “More details to come but look for something that has a real traditional fair feel to it”.

Established in 1949 to produce the annual County Fair, the Solano County Fair Association is a 501(c)3 non-profit agency that is governed by a Board of Directors which is appointed by the Solano County Board of Supervisors. The Solano County Fair Association has been providing educational, cultural, artistic, commercial, and recreational programs to the residents of Solano County for over 70 years. The mission of the Solano County Fair Association is “to ensure a positive experience for the public by providing a year-round multi-purpose venue that showcases and celebrates the wide variety of resources and activities available to our diverse community.”
